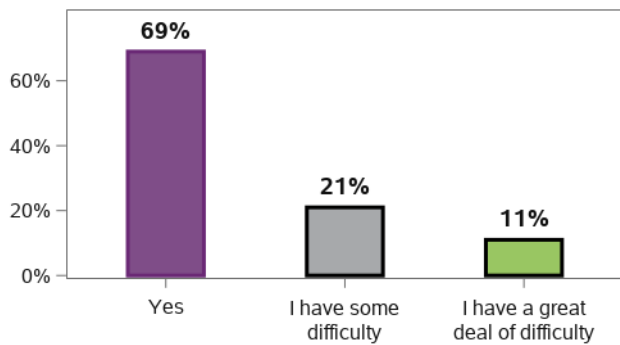

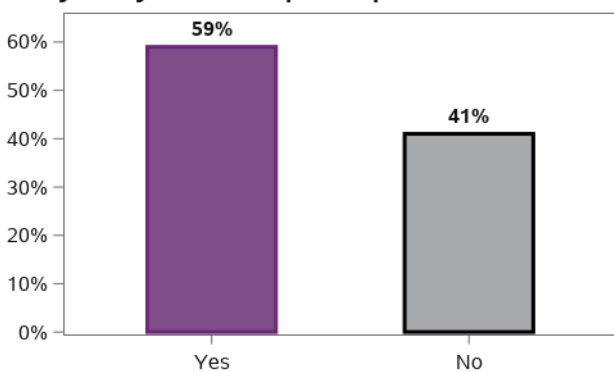

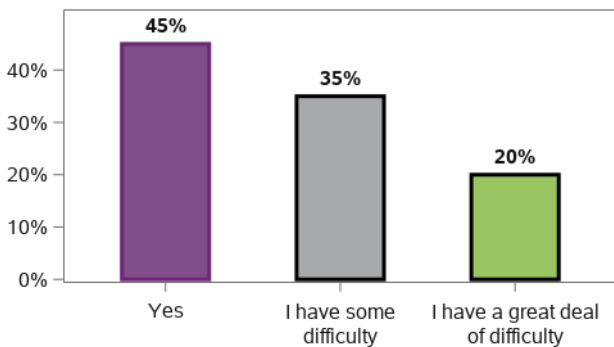

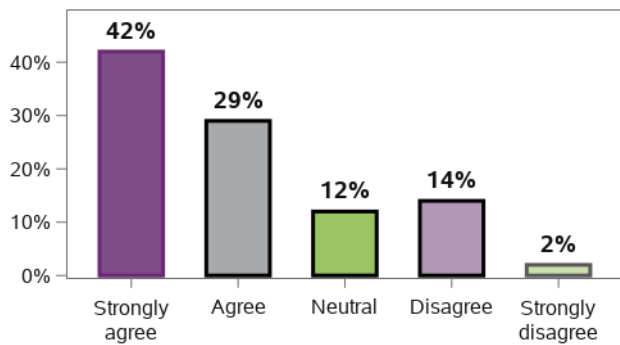

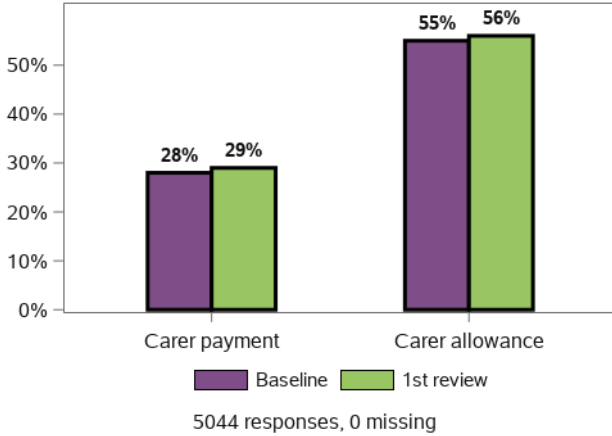
Plan cost allocation

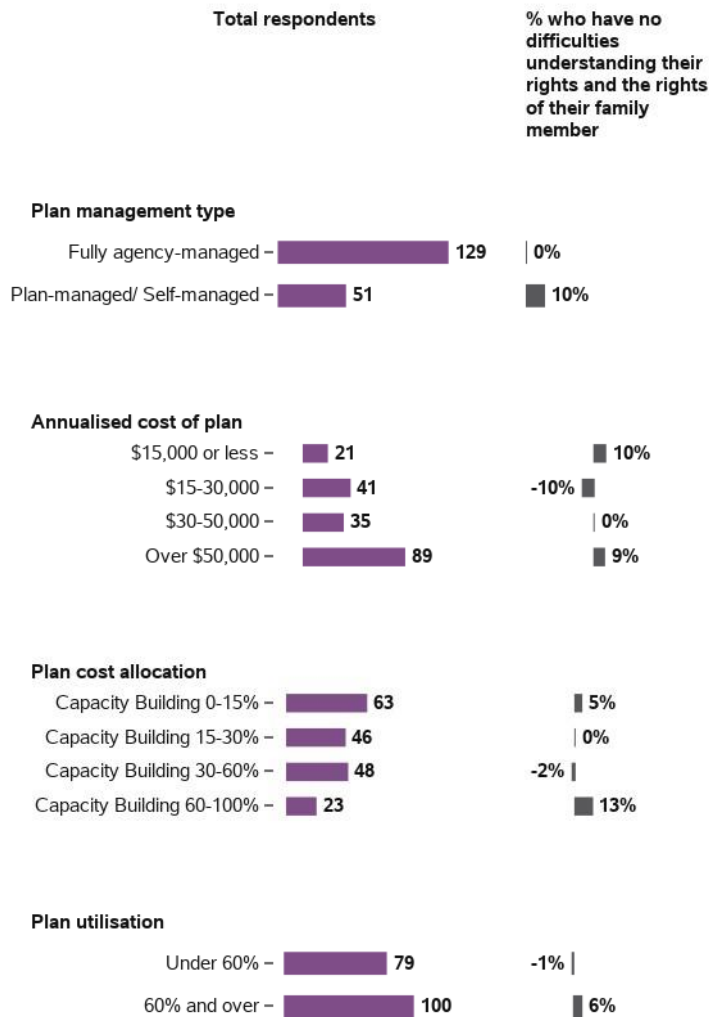

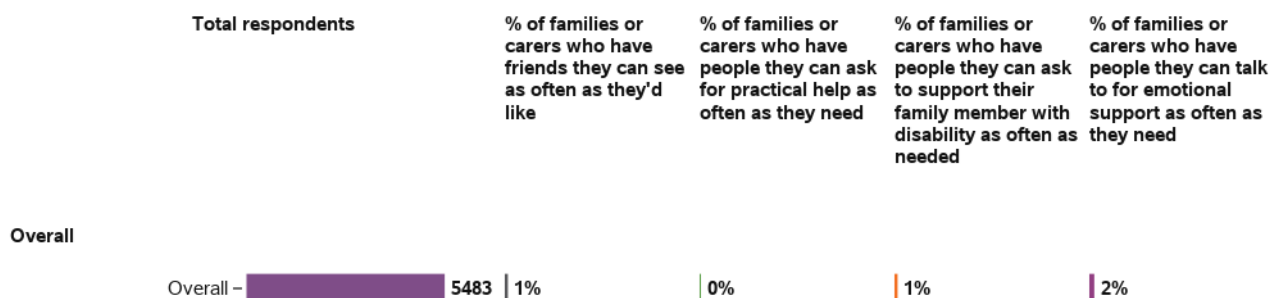

Longitudinal change in indicators for LF from baseline to 1st review - participant characteristics



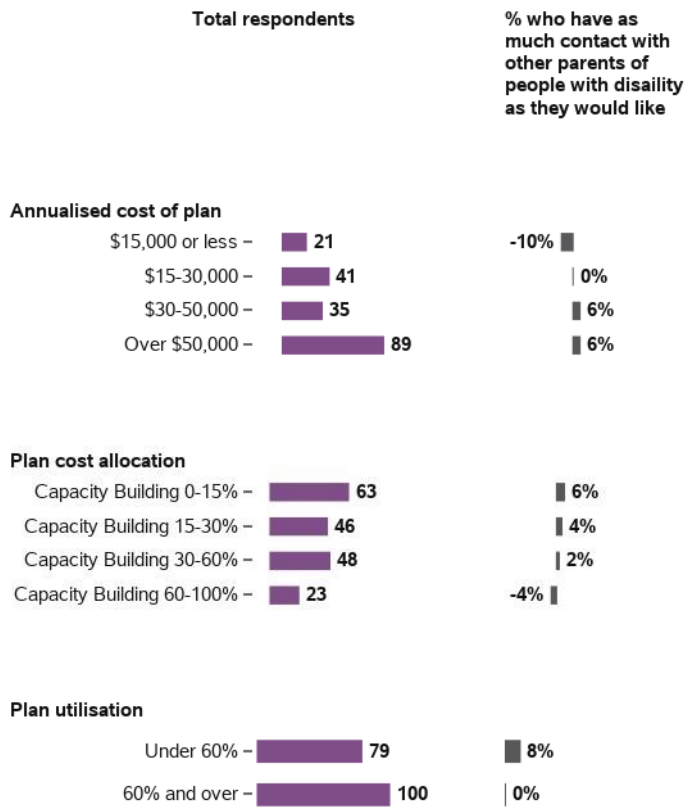

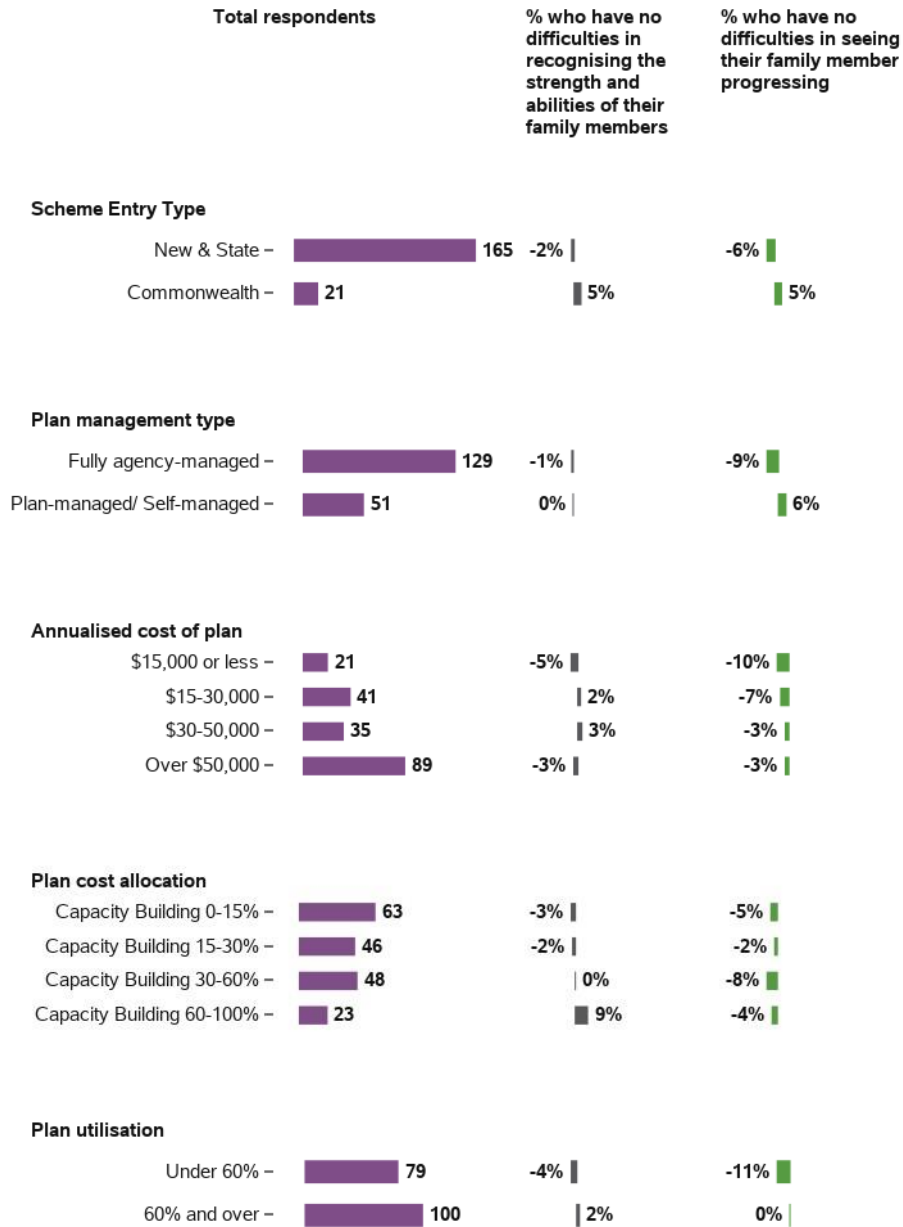

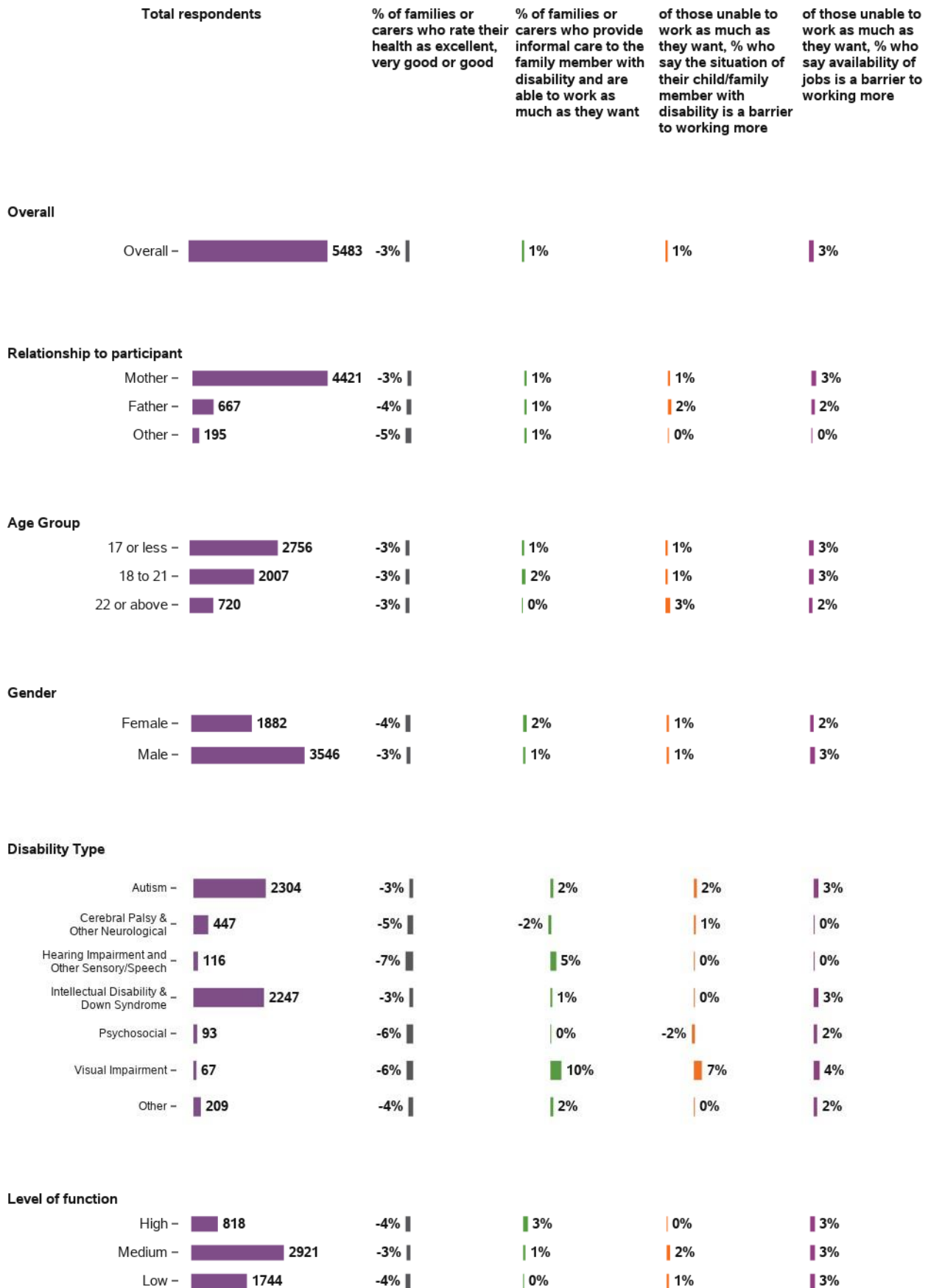

Longitudinal change in indicators for LF from baseline to 1st review - participant characteristics



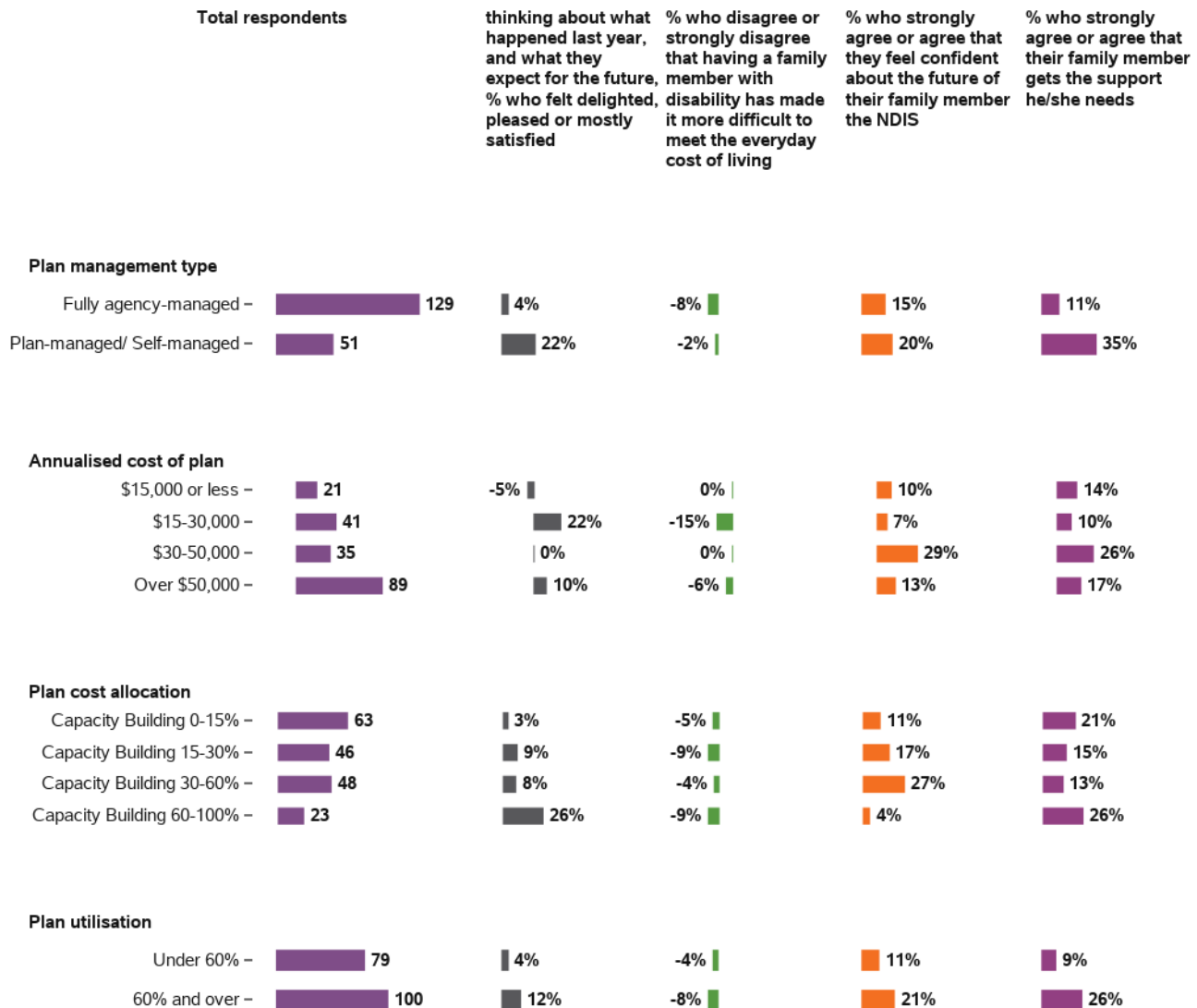

Longitudinal change in indicators for LF from baseline to 2nd review - participant characteristics



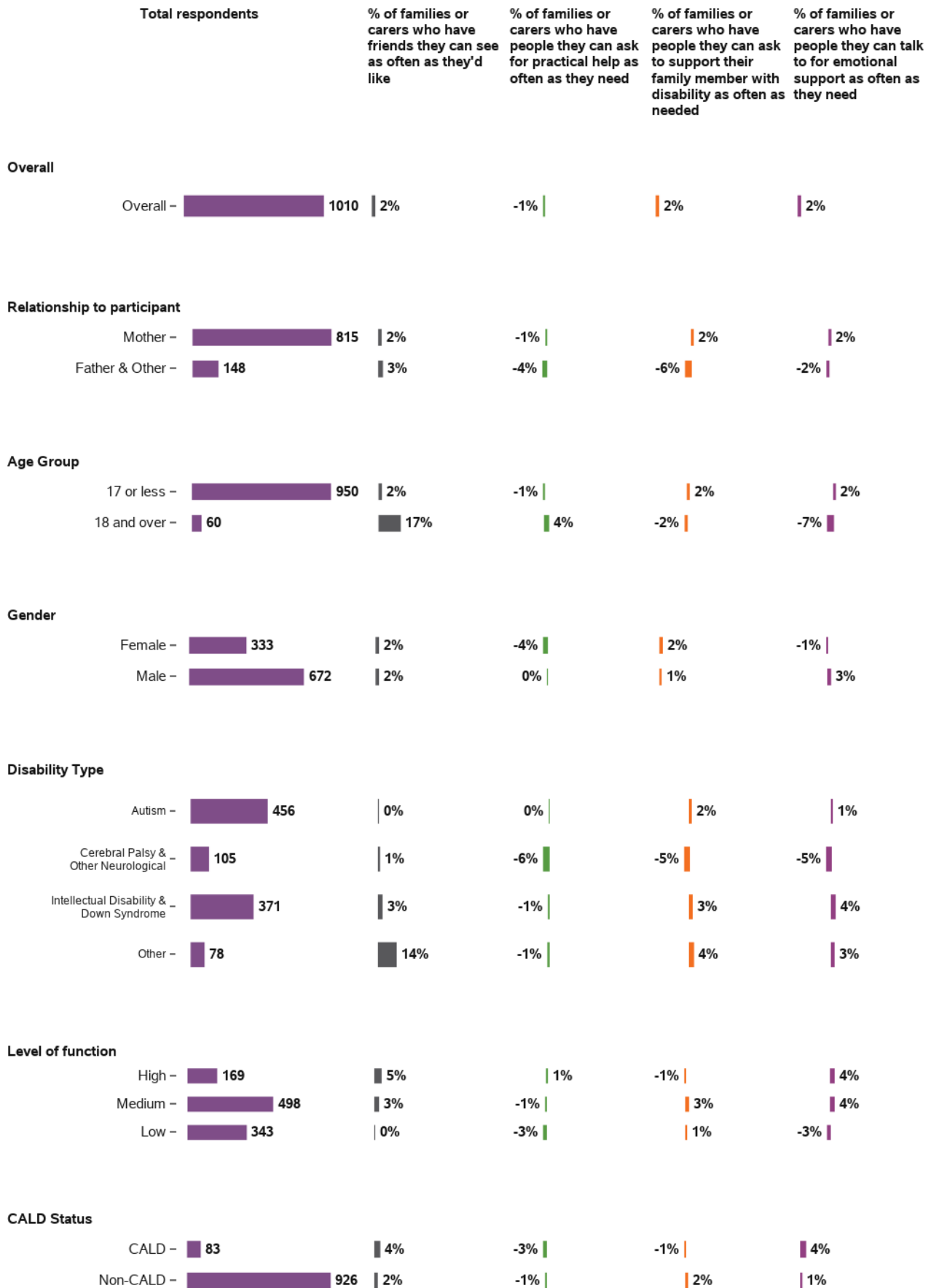

Longitudinal change in indicators for SF from baseline to 2nd review - participant characteristics



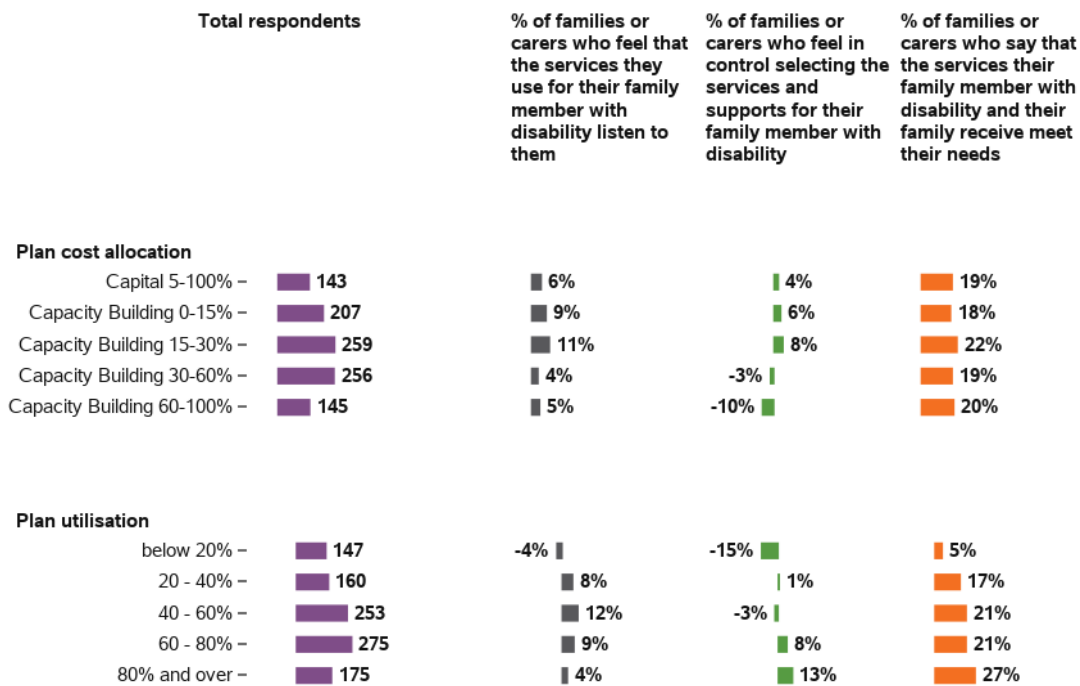
