








Appendix E.6.3 - Choice and control Change in longitudinal indicators from baseline to first review for SF - by participant characteristics

















Appendix E.6.6 - Specialist services Change in longitudinal indicators from baseline to first review for LF - by participant characteristics







Appendix E.7.3 - Choice and control Change in longitudinal indicators from baseline to second review for SF - by participant characteristics











Appendix E.7.4 - Relationships Change in longitudinal indicators from baseline to second review for SF - by participant








Change in longitudinal indicators from baseline to second review for SF - by participant characteristics (continued)





Change in longitudinal indicators from baseline to second review for LF - by participant characteristics






Appendix E.7.5 - Social, community and civic participation Change in longitudinal indicators from baseline to second review for SF - by participant characteristics















Appendix E.7.6 - Specialist services Change in longitudinal indicators from baseline to second review for LF - by participant characteristics



Appendix E.8 - Participants from birth to starting school - Change in longitudinal indicators from baseline to third review - C3 cohort - by participant characteristics







Appendix E.8.2 - Daily living Change in longitudinal indicators from baseline to third review for SF - by participant characteristics








Appendix E.8.3 - Choice and control Change in longitudinal indicators from baseline to third review for SF - by participant characteristics









Daily living: Has the NDIS improved your child's development?








