
Appendix H.6 - Participants aged 25 and over - Change in longitudinal indicators from baseline to first review - C1 cohort - by participant characteristics




Change in longitudinal indicators from baseline to second review for LF - by participant characteristics








Appendix H.7.7 - Work Change in longitudinal indicators from baseline to second review for LF - by participant














Appendix H.8.8 - Social, community and civic participation Change in longitudinal indicators from baseline to third review for SF - by participant characteristics (continued)





Change in longitudinal indicators from baseline to third review for LF - by participant characteristics
































Appendix H.11 - Participants aged 25 and over - Has The NDIS helped? indicators at second review - by participant characteristics

















Appendix H.12 - Participants aged 25 and over - Has The NDIS helped? indicators at third review - by participant characteristics
