SDA is a range of housing designed for people with extreme functional impairment or very high needs. SDA dwellings have accessible features to help residents live more independently and allow other supports to be delivered better or more safely.

SDA data project

The NDIA is working to improve the public data shared for SDA through the SDA data project.

The project aims to improve accessibility and reliability of SDA data, support informed decision making, and guide providers and investors to address future SDA needs.

We are working with Finity Consulting to understand what SDA data is helpful to SDA providers, investors, participants and their families and carers. Finity recently consulted over 100 stakeholders for their insights.
